Tuesday, June 15, 2021

The Gulf County School Board met in regular session Tuesday, June 15, 2021, at 9:45 (Agenda-Review Workshop) and 10:00 (School Board Meeting) at their Administrative Office in Port St. Joe. Superintendent Norton, Attorney Costin, and the following Board Members were present: Chairman Cindy Belin, Vice-Chairman Denny McGlon, Marvin Davis, Ruby Knox, and Brooke Wooten.

Belin, Vice-Chairman Denny McGlon, Marvin Davis, Ruby Knox, and Brooke Wooten. **Agenda-Review Workshop:** The board reviewed the June 15 agenda packet. **BOARD MEETING:** CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Belin called the meeting to order at 10:00. I. II. **ADOPTION OF AGENDA:** On motion by Mr. McGlon and seconded by Mr. Davis the board unanimously approved the amended agenda to include the addition of pages 3.01, 4A, 4.01-4.06, 5.01, 5.02, 10, 10.01, 19.02A-19.02A10, 19.02B-19.02B23, 19.02C-19.02C01, and 22, and the replacement of pages 4 and 5. III. HEAR FROM THE PUBLIC: Mr. Grady "Buck" Booth addressed the board requesting they make every effort to ensure that Gulf County School District's biological science curriculum does not solely educate students on the Theory of Evolution to the exclusion of other science-based viewpoints. He stressed there are other science-based options that should be included in the district's science curriculum. Mr. Norton stated that he recently received a complaint/concern about material in some of the history books. Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum - Lori Price, assured Mr. Booth that Gulf District Schools' curriculum does not solely teach/promote the Theory of Evolution, but exposes the students to other science-based viewpoints as well. She further assured Mr. Booth that she would make contact with other Florida districts (particularly Holmes County and Baker County, as he requested) to see how they address various theories/viewpoints in their science curriculum. The discussion continued from evolution to the subject of Critical Race Theory, with Superintendent noting that Governor Ron DeSantis announced that Florida has banned the teaching of critical race theory (CRT) in public schools. Superintendent Norton and Board Member Davis each stated their positions on the teaching of CRT.
