



## District & School Report Cards

District and School Report Cards are now available for viewing at EduData (<http://edudata.fldoe.org>). They include 2020-2021 data and have been redesigned to meet the requirements outlined in the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). The report cards serve as a valuable resource for understanding important information about Gulf District and our schools. They offer greater transparency into how the state, districts, and schools are doing with regard to student achievement and success, including subgroup information, on the following key performance indicators for each school, as required by ESSA, the overall summative rating (district grade\*, school grade\* or school improvement rating); the breakdown of each component in the overall rating; whether a school is identified for support and detailed reasons for the identification; academic achievement, growth and participation, including alternate assessment participation; English Language Learners' proficiency and progress; middle school and college & career acceleration; discipline and attendance; graduation and postsecondary continuation; long-term goals and interim progress; accelerated course enrollment; and preschool enrollment.
