

# GULF COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD

Tuesday, August 2, 2022

The Gulf County School Board met in regular session Tuesday, August 2, 2022, at 4:00 (Workshop) and 5:15 (Public Hearing on 2022-2023 Tentative Budget and School Board Meeting) at their Administrative Office in Port St. Joe.
