#### FAST Progress Monitoring (PM1, PM2, and PM3)

Grades 3–10 FAST ELA Reading and grades 3–8 FAST Mathematics assessments are aligned to the Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards (links below). PM1 and PM2 are intended to provide baseline and mid-year results to identify areas that may need additional instruction and support. PM3 provides a summative score at the end of the year to measure student mastery of the grade-level content standards. PM3 ELA Reading is utilized to determine promotion in Grade 3.


